The Facts:

Domestic abuse includes coercive control, emotional abuse, sexual abuse, physical abuse, economic abuse, harassment, stalking and online abuse >>> 1 in 4 women in England and Wales will experience domestic abuse in their lifetime

- 2 women are killed every week in England and Wales by a current or former partner
- On average, a woman is assaulted 35 times before she >>>> calls the police
- Children are victims too. They can experience trauma >>>> for the rest of their lives

Look out for others

Women don't always recognise when they are living with abuse. Look out for your friends and loved ones. Talk to them, listen and signpost for specialist help.
